Dr. Beeman received his doctorate at St. Antony's College, Oxford, in 1998 where he completed a thesis on Japanese antitrust politics. Dr. Beeman was a Fulbright Graduate Research Fellow at the MITI Research Institute (1991-92), a Monbusho Research Fellow at the University of Tokyo (1996-97), and an

Advanced Research Fellow at Harvard University's Program on U.S.-Japan Relations (1997-98). Over the past year, Dr. Beeman has been a Research Fellow at the Reischauer Center for East Asian Studies at the Nitze School of Advanced International Studies, Johns Hopkins University. His publications include a chapter in a forthcoming book on comparative antitrust policy regimes as well as the forthcoming publication of his thesis. Dr. Beeman currently is employed in the Federal Government.
