Gillian Tett is the former Tokyo Bureau Chief for the *Financial Times* (FT). She is currently on leave to write a book about Japan's financial system while contributing occasional articles to the FT. Dr. Tett first worked as a freelance journalist in Russia, Central Asia and the Baltic States, before joining the FT in 1993 as a foreign reporter. From 1994-5, she was based at the FT's London headquarters as UK Economics reporter. From 1995-96, she was the FT's Economics Correspondent, with special responsibility for the European Monetary Union. Gillian has been a Financial Times Tokyo Correspondent since 1997 and became the FT Tokyo Bureau Chief in the summer of 2000. Dr. Tett received her BA and PhD in Social Anthropology at Cambridge University.
